

Bohemia deals a nasty hand, Unangst wins with three of a kind

Hawghunters third visit in 2010 to the Chesapeake Bay proved to be another tough tournament. The previous two tournaments held at the NorthEast River and Dundee Creek were won with over 10 lbs, but the remaining anglers found themselves weighing one or two fish or none at all. Bohemia river proved to be just as difficult. With water temperatures in the low 80's and a lack of milfoil that is usually present in the river, anglers were forced to dig deep into their tackle to find a lure that would draw a strike.

Kim Unangst found the right bait to fool three bass and win his second tournament this year. Those three bass weighed 4.7 pounds and also included the tournament lunker of 1.82 pounds. Three bass may not seem like much, but no other angler weighed more than one fish. Equally impressive, was that Kim fished the entire tournament without his raingear despite the sporadic but steady rain during most of the tournament.

In second place was Burr Shaw with 1.7 pounds just two weeks after being voted in as a new member. The remaining top 5 were Jon Hardenberg 1.49 pounds; Brad Keding 1.33 pounds; and Tim McNicholas 1.06 pounds. There were no other fish weighed by the other three anglers.

Hawghunters next stop will be August 29th at Greenwood Lake on the border of New York and New Jersey. Anglers can fish with either license and there are five boaters and three riders in the draw.
